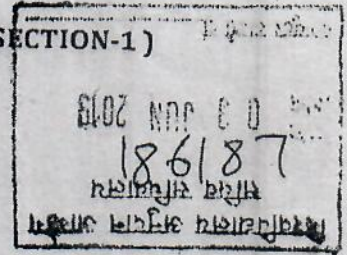

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an Institution of higher learning as an Institution deemed to be University.

2. **And whereas**, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, vide its Notification No.9-46/2008-U3(A) dated 10.07.2009, on the advice of UGC, had declared Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (ILBS), New Delhi as an Institution deemed to be University for the purpose of the aforesaid act, for a provisional period of five years.

3. **And whereas**, the functioning of ILBS, New Delhi was reviewed by the UGC with the help of its Expert Committee during 15-16th October, 2018. The report of the Expert Committee was placed before the Commission in its 539th meeting held on 26.02.2019. The Commission considered the report and the following resolution forwarded to this Ministry:

"The Commission considered the report of the UGC Expert Committee and resolved to recommend to MHRD for continuation of status of Deemed to be University to Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (ILBS), New Delhi. The suggestions of the visiting Expert Committee, if any, will be addressed by the Deemed to be University within a period of 6 months and the compliance report would be submitted alongwith documentary proof to UGC".

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the UGC, do hereby extend / regularize the deemed to be University status to **Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (ILBS), New Delhi** from 10.07.2014 onwards with the condition that the Institute shall submit compliance report in respect of the suggestions given by the UGC Expert Committee.

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5. The all other conditions mentioned in the earlier Notification(s) of this Ministry as well as the Rules / Regulations of UGC and other Statutory Councils, issued from time to time, shall continue to be adhered by Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (ILBS), New Delhi.
